3rd Forklift Operator Contest Held

– Reaffirming safety awareness and basic operations through a competition, with the aim of preventing industrial and product accidents –

The SBS Group held the "3rd SBS Group Forklift Operator Contest" on Saturday, October 28 at Toyota L&F Customers Center Tokyo (Ichikawa City, Chiba Prefecture).



The purpose of this contest is to raise awareness of safety and promote the prevention of industrial and product accidents through a competition related to the advanced operating skills and specialized knowledge of relevant laws and regulations, vehicle structures, etc., required of forklift operators. At this event, which was held for the first time in four years following the end of the COVID-19 pandemic, 22 competitors from business sites across Japan participated in a heated competition in two categories, counterbalance trucks and reach trucks.



- ◆ Date and time: 9:30 am to 4:00 pm on Saturday, October 28
- ◆ Venue: Toyota L&F Customers Center Tokyo
- ◆ Competitions: Academic examination, inspection, operating/Maximum of 100 points in each competition, for a total of 300 points
- ◆ Number of participants: 8 in counterbalance category/14 in reach category, 22 in total

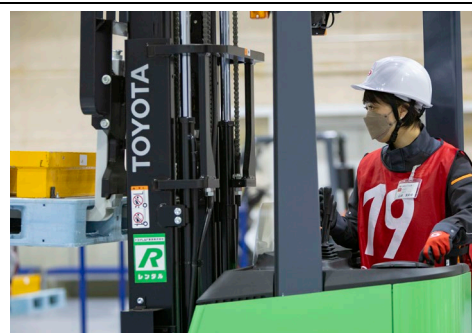


Image of competition
