## 6th SBS Group Driver Contest Held


Toward an accident-free society and an accident-free logistics company

The SBS Group held the 6th Driver Contest on November 18 at Anesaki Driving School of Group company SBS Driving School Co., Ltd. (President: Tatsuya Morii, Head Office: Inage-ku, Chiba City, Chiba Prefecture) with the aim of improving the safety knowledge and driving skills of drivers and promoting safety awareness throughout the Group.



Since 2016, the SBS Group has been holding Driver Contests for the entire Group, aiming to achieve an accident-free society and an accident-free logistics company. This year, a total of 27 male and female contestants from Group companies spanning from Hokkaido to Kyushu were invited to participate, and a total of 220 people including the representative Masahiko Kamata, executives of each company, their managers and colleagues participates. The contest consisted of three categories: (1) daily inspections, (2) driving, and (3) theory, and was divided into two divisions: a medium-duty division for driving 4-ton trucks and a light-duty division for driving 1.5-ton trucks.

After a heated game, Katsuo Omura of SBS Freight Service Co., Ltd. won the medium-duty division, while Koji Yamamoto of SBS Zentsu Co., Ltd. won the light-duty division. In each division, the score exceeded that of last year's winner, showing that the level of the contest has improved. In addition, two female athletes performed well, finishing third in the medium-duty division and second in the light-duty division.
